The *Talisman*, Western Kentucky's yearbook, recalls the first Homecoming Game on the Hill (Nov. 5, 1927) in its 1928 edition:

brought the haughty banner of the vaunted University of Louisville team to the dust with a 7-to-6 victory. The spectators were treated to a perfect ball game, when, *during sixty minutes of perfectly coordinated and fierce attack, not a substitution was made*. Revenge is sweet, as all we who remember last year know. The day was a complete success."
